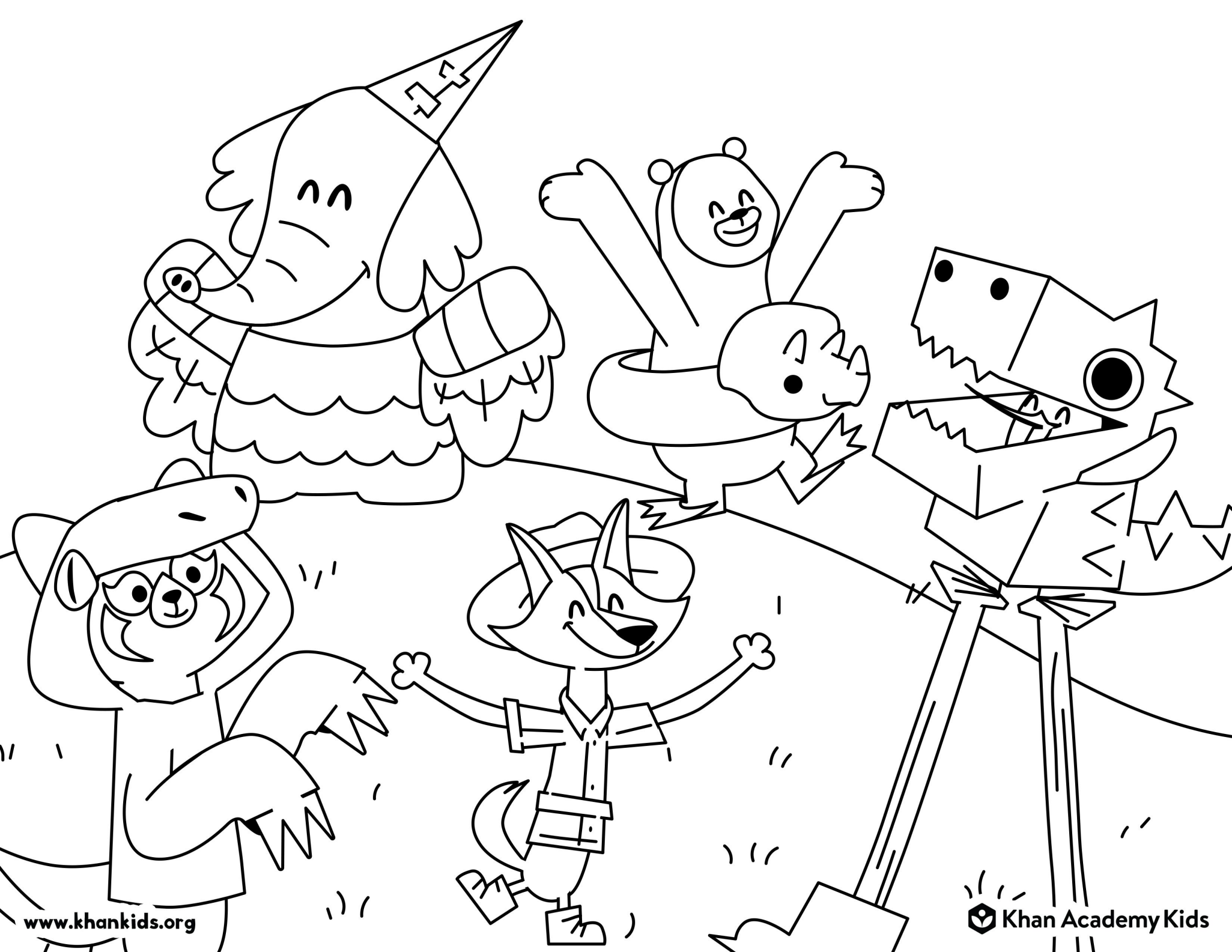

Addition means you move right on the number line. You are adding more, so the numbers get bigger.

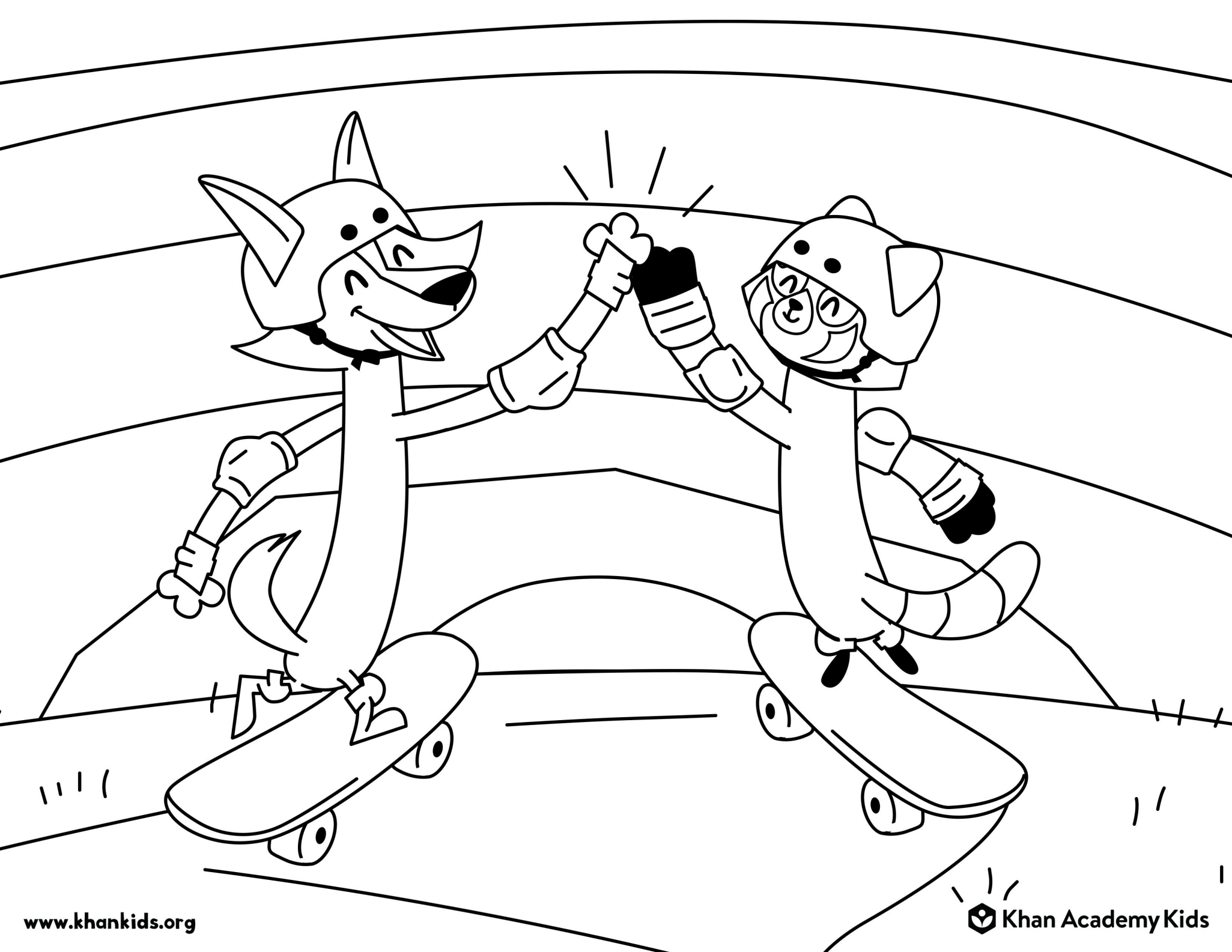
